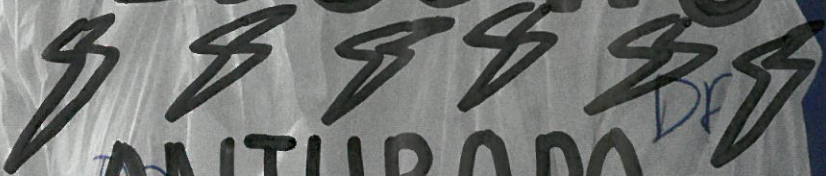


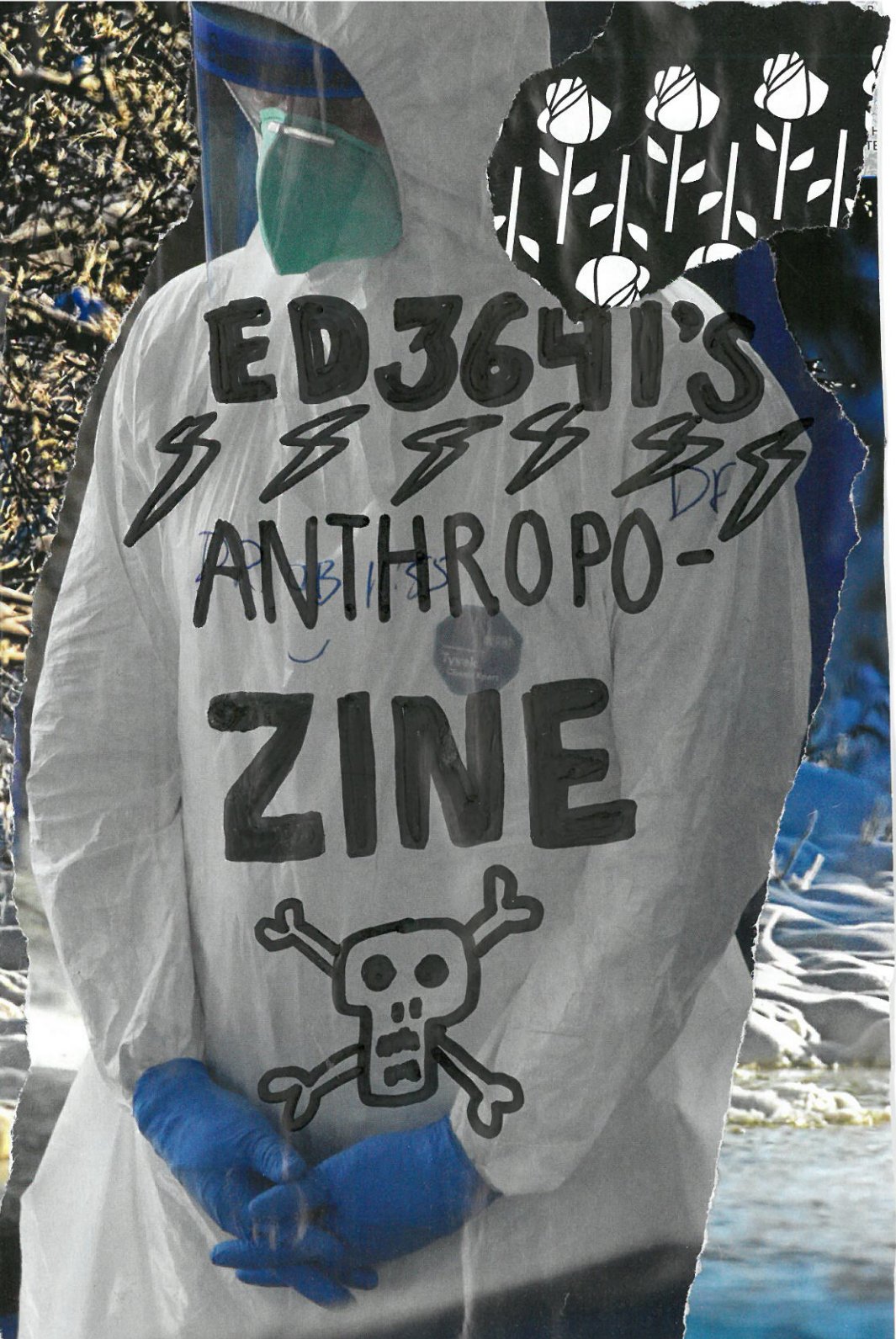

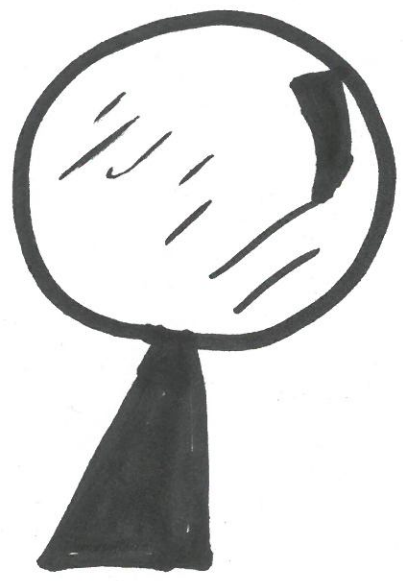

Slow violence encompasses a range of topics

• deforestation → the removal of a forest or a stand of trees from land then converted to a non forest use. This can involve the conversion of forest land to farms, ranches or urban use.



Climate change: a change in global or regional climate patterns. This is the most urgent problem facing humanity.



Oil Spills: the release of a liquid petroleum hydrocarbon into the environment, especially the marine ecosystem by humans.

Our environment is the medium for the infliction of slow violence. This concept requires our understanding of the harm we inflict by consumption production etc.

Slow violence is neither spectacular or instantaneous but instead incremental, the repercussions are postponed for years, decades or centuries.

Respect for the environment means more than not destroying it; it also means using it for good purposes.

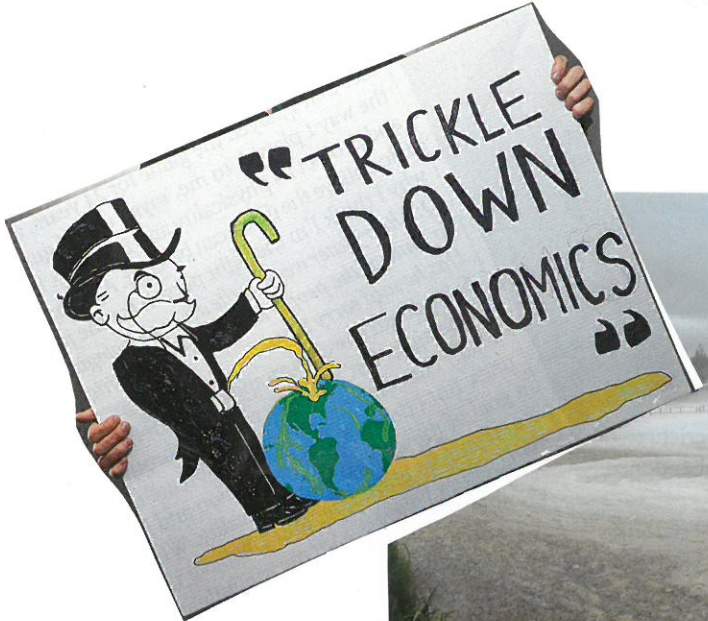
